FIRST CONDITIONAL



The first conditional is used to express a real or very probable situation in the future. It is common when we are talking about possible plans, promises, warnings, threats or for persuading someone.

Conditional Sentences: The First Conditional

THE FIRST CONDITIONAL

The condition → **if** + **present simple**, The result → **future tense with Will / Won't**

- If I have money, I will buy a modern cell phone.
- If I don't have money, I won't buy a modern cell phone.
- If my mother travels to Spain, she will have a good job.
(travel) (have)
- What will you do if you fail the next exam?
(you/do)
- If I fail the next exam, I will feel sad.
(fail) (feel)

Examples

- If it **rains**, I **won't go** to the park.
- If I **study** today, I **ll go** to the party tonight.
- If I **have** enough money, I **ll buy** some new shoes.
- She **ll be** late if the train **is** delayed.
- She **ll miss** the bus if she **doesn't leave** soon.
- If I **see** her, I **ll tell** her.

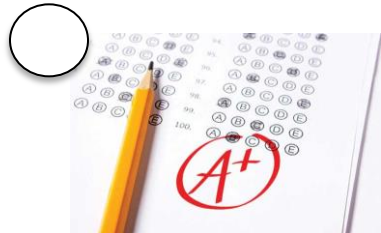
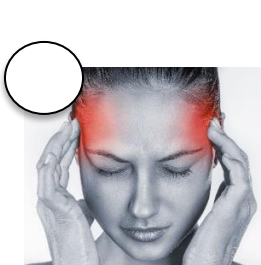
